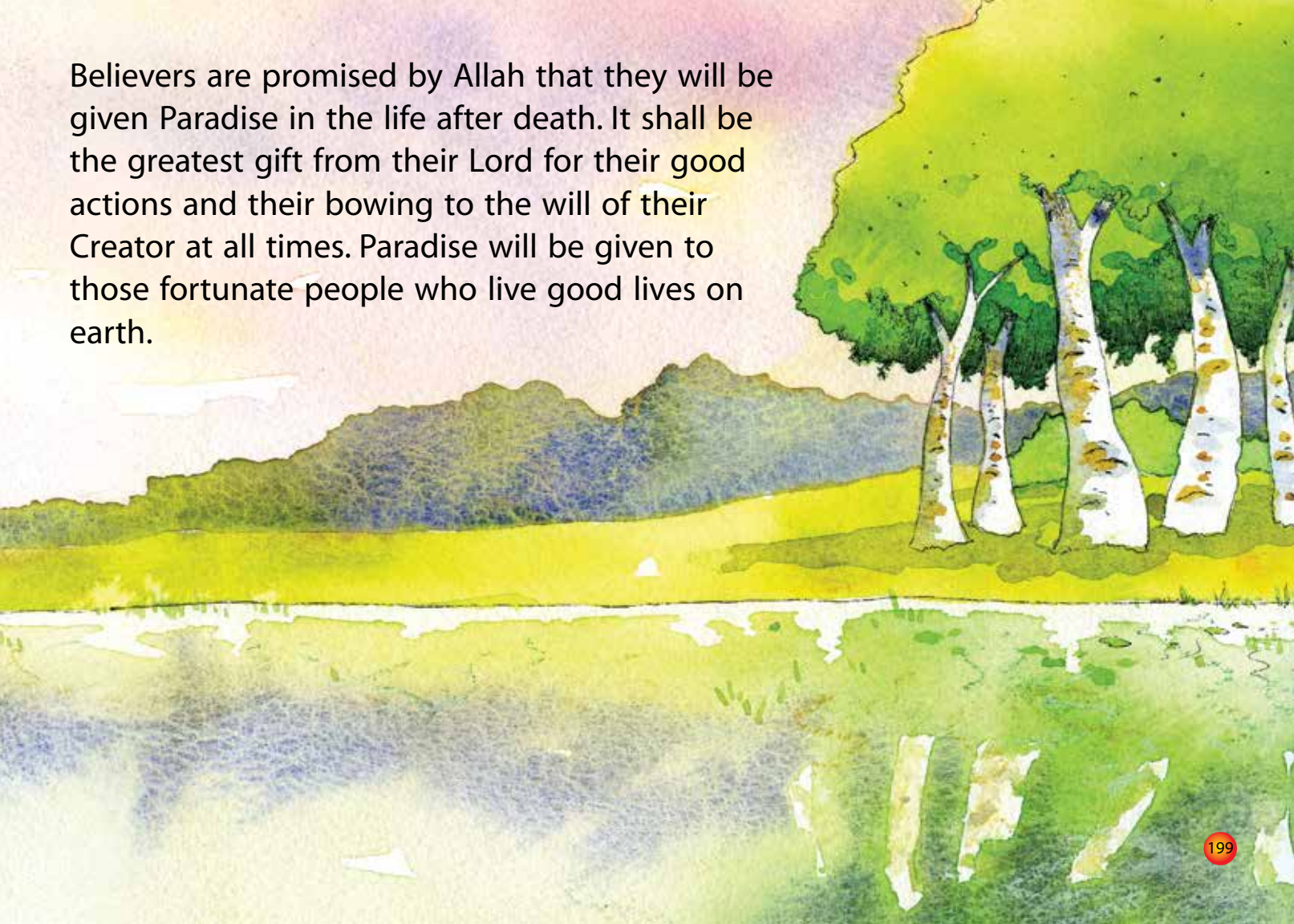









The true believer is a flower of the garden of Paradise. It sprouts in this world and blossoms in the Hereafter.
