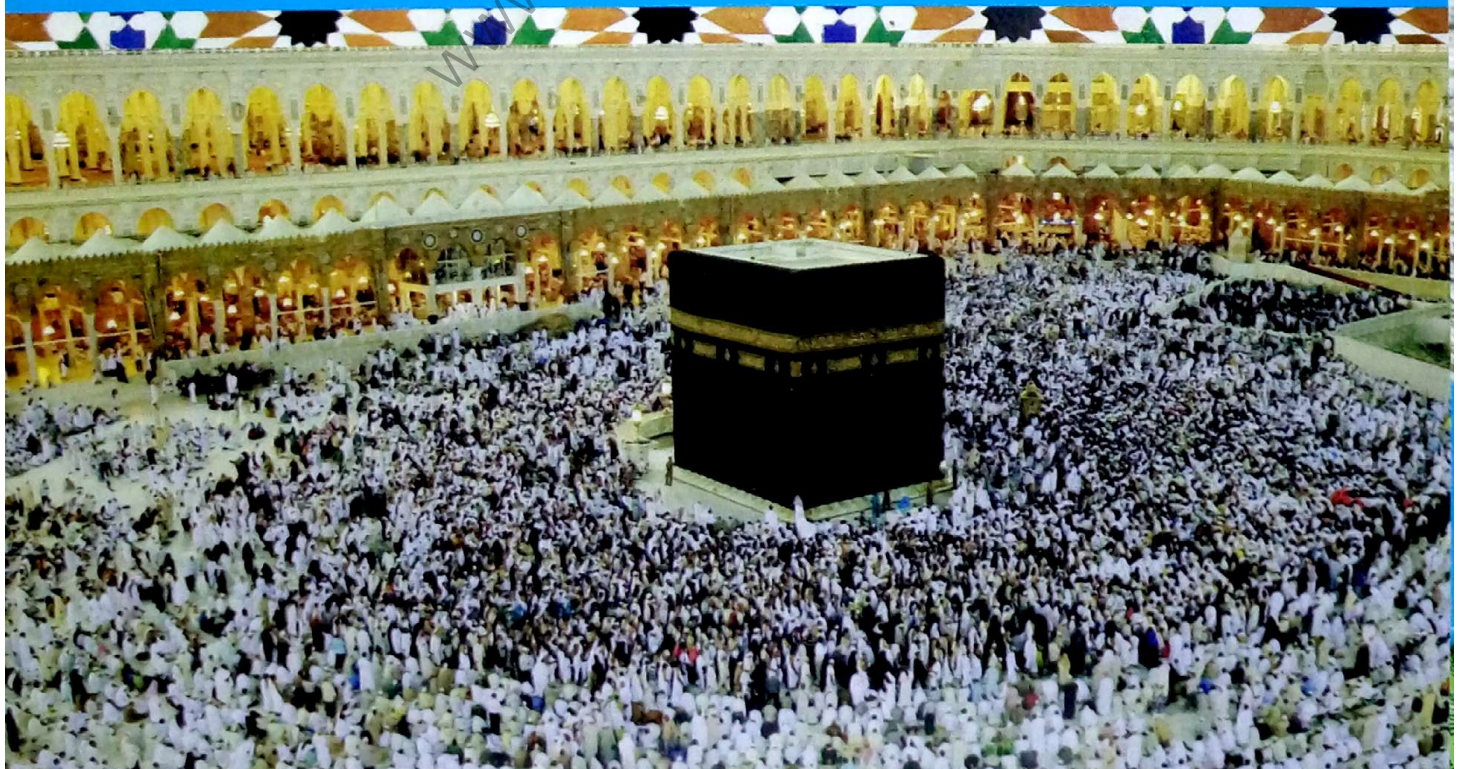




A-Z READY REFERENCE OF THE QURAN

A

Aaron

- 2:248 "...and the relics left by the family of Moses and the family of *Aaron*, carried by angels..."
- 4:163 We sent inspiration to Abraham, Ishmael, Isaac, Jacob, and the Tribes, to Jesus, Job, Jonah, *Aaron*, and Solomon,...
- 6:84 and before him We guided Noah, and among his progeny, David, Solomon, Job, Joseph, Moses, and *Aaron*:
- 7:122 "The Lord of Moses and *Aaron*."
- 7:142 And Moses had charged his brother *Aaron* (before he went up):
- 7:150 *Aaron* said: "Son of my mother! the people did indeed reckon me as naught, and went near to slaying me!
- 10:75 Then after them sent We Moses and *Aaron* to Pharaoh and his chiefs with Our Signs.
- 19:28 "O sister of *Aaron*! your father was not a man of evil, nor your mother a woman unchaste!"
- 19:53 And, out of Our Mercy, We gave him his brother *Aaron*, (also) a prophet.
- 20:30 "*Aaron*, my brother;
- 20:70 So the magicians were thrown down to prostration: they said, "We believe in the Lord of *Aaron* and Moses."
- 20:90 *Aaron* had already, before this said to them: "O my people! you are being tested in this:
- 20:92 (Moses) said: "O *Aaron*! what kept you back, when you saw them going wrong,
- 21:48 In the past We granted to Moses and *Aaron* the Criterion (for judgement), and a Light and a

Message for those who would do right—

- 23:45 Then We sent Moses and his brother *Aaron*, with Our Signs and authority manifest,
- 25:35 (Before this,) We sent Moses the Book, and appointed his brother *Aaron* with him as Minister;
- 26:13 "My breast will be straitened. And my speech may not go (smoothly); so send unto *Aaron*."
- 26:48 "The Lord of Moses and *Aaron*."
- 28:34 "And my brother *Aaron*—he is more eloquent in speech than I:
- 37:114 Again (of old) We bestowed Our favour on Moses and *Aaron*,
- 37:120 "Peace and salutation to Moses and *Aaron*!"

Abandon

- 2:243 Did you not turn by vision to those who *abandoned* their homes, though they were thousands (in number), for fear of death?
- 7:127 Said the chiefs of Pharaoh's people: "Will you leave Moses and his people, to spread mischief in the land and to *abandon* you and your gods?"
- 9:16 Or think you that you shall be *abandoned*, as though Allah did not know those among you who strive with might and main,...
- 12:37 I have (I assure you) *abandoned* the ways of a people that believe not in Allah and that (even) deny the Hereafter.
- 20:91 They had said: "We will not *abandon* this cult, but we will devote ourselves to it until Moses returns to us."
- 71:23 "And they have said (to each other), 'Abandon neither Wadd

- some mercy after *adversity* has touched them, behold! they take to plotting against Our Signs!
- 11:10 But if We give him a taste of (Our) favours after *adversity* has touched him, he is sure to say, "All evil has departed from me."
- 36:23 If (Allah) Most Gracious should intend some *adversity* for me, of no use whatever will be their intercession for me, nor can they deliver me.
- 41:50 When We give him a taste of some mercy from Ourselves, after some *adversity* has touched him, he is sure to say,...

Advice

- 7:62 Sincere is my *advice* to you, and I know from Allah something that you know not.
- 28:20 He said: "O Moses! the Chiefs are taking counsel together about you, to slay you: so get you away, for I do give you sincere *advice*."

Advise

- 27:32 She said: "You chiefs! *advise* me in (this) my affair: no affair have I decided except in your presence."

Adviser

- 7:21 And he swore to them both, that he was their *sincere adviser*.
- 7:68 I am to you a sincere and trustworthy *adviser*.

Affection

- 4:73 But if good fortune comes to you from Allah, they would be sure to say—as if there had never been ties of *affection* between you and them—
- 8:63 And (moreover) He has put *affection* between their hearts:
- 8:63 Not if you had spent all that is in the earth, could you have produced that *affection*, but Allah has done it.
- 16:78 and He gave you hearing and sight and intelligence and *affections*: that you may give thanks (to Allah).

- 18:81 "So we desired that their Lord would give them in exchange (a son) better in purity (of conduct) and closer in *affection*."
- 59:9 show their *affection* to such as came to them for refuge, and entertain no desire in their hearts for things given to the (latter),...

Afflict

- 2:156 Who say, when *afflicted* with calamity: "To Allah we belong, and to Him is our return:"—
- 6:42 ...and We *afflicted* the nations with suffering and adversity, that they might learn humility.
- 7:141 And remember We rescued you from Pharaoh's people, who *afflicted* you with the worst of penalties,...
- 7:167 Behold! your Lord did declare that He would send against them, to the Day of Judgement, those who would *afflict* them with grievous penalty.
- 8:29 ...remove from you (all) evil (that may *afflict*) you, and forgive you: for Allah is the Lord of grace unbounded.
- 19:45 "O my father! I fear lest a Penalty *afflict* you from (Allah) Most Gracious, so that you become to Satan a friend."
- 20:47 send forth, therefore, the Children of Israel with us, and *afflict* them not:
- 24:61 It is no fault in the blind nor in one born lame, nor in one *afflicted* with illness, nor in yourselves,...
- 30:36 and when some evil *afflicts* them because of what their (own) hands have sent forth, behold, they are in despair!
- 38:41 "Behold", he cried to his Lord: "The Evil One has *afflicted* me with distress and suffering!"
- 68:6 Which of you is *afflicted* with madness.

Affliction

- 6:17 "If Allah touch you with *affliction*, none can remove it but He;

- 7:99 Did they then feel secure against the Plan of *Allah*?—
- 7:101 Thus does *Allah* seal up the hearts of those who reject Faith.
- 7:105 One for whom it is right to say nothing but truth about *Allah*.
- 7:128 For the earth is *Allah*'s, to give as a heritage to such of His servants as He pleases;
- 7:128 Said Moses to his people: "Pray for help from *Allah*, and (wait) in patience and constancy:
- 7:140 He said: "Shall I seek for you a god other than the (true) God, when it is *Allah* Who has endowed you with gifts above the nations?"
- 7:143 *Allah* said: "By no means can you see Me (direct);
- 7:158 So believe in *Allah* and His Messenger, the unlettered Prophet, who believes in *Allah* and His Words:
- 7:164 When some of them said: "Why do you preach to a people whom *Allah* will destroy or visit with a terrible punishment?"—
- 7:169 Was not the Covenant of the Book taken from them, that they would not ascribe to *Allah* anything but the truth?
- 7:171 ...and bring (ever) remembrance what is therein; perchance you may fear *Allah*."
- 7:178 Whom *Allah* does guide—he is on the right path:
- 7:180 The most beautiful names belong to *Allah*: so call Him by them;
- 7:185 Do they see nothing in the government of the heavens and the earth and all that *Allah* has created?
- 7:186 To such as *Allah* rejects from His guidance, there can be no guide:
- 7:187 Say: "The knowledge thereof is with *Allah* (alone), but most men know not."
- 7:188 Say: "I have no power over any good or harm to myself except as *Allah* wills.
- 7:189 When she grows heavy, they both pray to *Allah* their Lord, (saying):
- 7:190 But *Allah* is exalted high above the partners they ascribe to Him.
- 7:194 Verily those whom you call upon besides *Allah* are servants like unto you:
- 7:196 "For my Protector is *Allah*, Who revealed the Book (from time to time), and He will choose and befriend the righteous.
- 7:200 If a suggestion from Satan assail your (mind), seek refuge with *Allah*; for he hears and knows (all things).
- 7:201 Those who fear *Allah*, when a thought of evil from Satan assaults them, bring *Allah* to remembrance, when look! they see (aright)!
- 8:1 Obey *Allah* and His Prophet, if you do believe."
- 8:1 Say: "(Such) spoils are at the disposal of *Allah* and the Prophet:
- 8:1 So fear *Allah*, and keep straight the relations between yourselves:
- 8:2 For, Believers are those who, when *Allah* is mentioned, feel a tremor in their hearts,...
- 8:7 Behold! *Allah* promised you one of the two (enemy) parties, that it should be yours:
- 8:7 You wished that the one unarmed should be yours, but *Allah* willed to justify the Truth according to His words and to cut off the roots of the Unbelievers—
- 8:10 *Allah* made it but a message of hope, and an assurance to your hearts:
- 8:13 If any contend against *Allah* and His Messenger, *Allah* is strict in punishment.
- 8:13 This because they contended against *Allah* and His Messenger:
- 8:14 Thus (will it be said): "Taste you then the (punishment): for those who resist *Allah*, is the penalty of the Fire."
- 8:16 he draws on himself the wrath of

(cooking) Cauldrons fixed (in their places):

Bathe

5:6 If you are in a state of ceremonial impurity, *bathe* your whole body.

Battle

3:121 Remember that morning you did leave your household (early) to post the Faithful at their stations for *battle*:

61:4 Truly Allah loves those who fight in His Cause in *battle* array, as if they were a solid cemented structure.

Battlefield

9:25 Assuredly Allah did help you in many *battlefields* and on the day of Hunayn:

'Be,' and it is!

2:117 When He decrees a matter, He says to it: "*Be,*" and it is.

3:47 He said: "Even so: Allah creates what He wills: When He has decreed a Plan, He but says to it, '*Be,*' and it is!"

3:59 He created him from dust, then said to him: "*Be:*" and he was.

6:73 The day He says, "*Be,*" behold! it is.

16:40 For to anything which We have willed, We but say the Word, "*Be,*" and it is.

19:35 Glory be to Him! when He determines a matter, He only says to it, "*Be,*" and it is.

36:82 Verily, when He intends a thing, His Command is, "*Be,*" and it is!

40:68 It is He Who gives Life and Death; and when He decides upon an affair, He says to it, "*Be,*" and it is.

Beaker

12:72 They said: "We miss the great *beaker* of the king; for him who produces it, is (the reward of) a camel load, I will be bound by it."

56:18 With goblets, (shining) *beakers*,

and cups (filled) out of clear-flowing fountains:

Beam

75:22 Some faces, that Day, will *beam* (in brightness and beauty)—

80:38 Some Faces that Day will be *beaming*,

83:24 You will recognise in their Faces the *beaming* brightness of Bliss.

Beard

20:94 (Aaron) replied: "O son of my mother! Seize (me) not by my *beard* nor by (the hair of) my head!

Beast

2:164 In the *beasts* of all kinds that He scatters through the earth;

8:22 For the worst of *beasts* in the sight of Allah are the deaf and the dumb—those who understand not.

8:55 For the worst of *beasts* in the sight of Allah are those who reject Him: they will not believe.

27:82 And when the Word is fulfilled against them (the unjust), We shall produce from the earth a *beast* to (face) them:

31:10 He set on the earth mountains standing firm, lest it should shake with you; and He scattered through it *beasts* of all kinds.

81:5 When the wild *beasts* are herded together (in the human habitations);

Beautiful

9:72 ...and *beautiful* mansions in Gardens of everlasting bliss.

9:72 ...and *beautiful* mansions in Gardens of everlasting bliss.

10:93 We settled the Children of Israel in a *beautiful* dwelling-place, and provided for them sustenance of the best:

18:31 they will recline therein on raised thrones. How good the recompense! How *beautiful* a couch to recline on!

Hear

7:43 And they shall *hear* the cry:
"Behold! the Garden before you!
you have been made its
inheritors, for your deeds (of
righteousness)."

7:100 ...if We so willed, We could
punish them (too) for their sins,
and seal up their hearts so that
they could not *hear*?

7:179 they have hearts wherewith they
understand not, eyes wherewith
they see not, and ears wherewith
they *hear* not.

7:195 Have they feet to walk with? Or
hands to lay hold with? Or eyes
to see with? Or ears to *hear* with?

7:198 If you call them to guidance, they
hear not. You will see them
looking at you, but they see not.

7:200 If a suggestion from Satan assail
your (mind), seek refuge with
Allah; for he *hears* and knows (all
things).

8:2 ...and when they *hear* His Signs
rehearsed, find their faith
strengthened, and put (all) their
trust in their Lord;

8:17 for Allah is He Who *hears* and
knows (all things).

8:20 O you who believe! Obey Allah
and His Prophet, and turn not
away from him when you *hear*
(him speak).

8:21 Nor the like those who say, "We
hear," but listen not:

8:31 "We have *heard* this (before): if we
wished, we could say (words) like
these: these are nothing but tales
of the ancients."

8:42 And verily Allah is He Who *hears*
and knows (all things).

8:53 And, verily, Allah is He Who
hears and knows (all things)."

8:61 for He is the One that *hears* and
knows (all things).

9:6 If one among the Pagans ask you
for asylum, grant it to him, so that
he may *hear* the Word of Allah;

9:98 on them be the disaster of Evil:
for Allah is He that *hears* and
knows (all things).

9:103 Verily your prayers are a source
of security for them: and Allah is
One Who *hears* and knows.

10:42 But can you make the deaf to
hear—even though they are
without understanding?

10:65 Let not their speech grieve you:
for all power and honour belong
to Allah: it is He Who *hears* and
knows (all things).

11:20 Their penalty will be doubled!
They lost the power to *hear*, and
they did not see!

11:24 These two kinds (of men) may be
compared to the blind and deaf,
and those who can see and *hear*
well.

12:31 When she *heard* of their malicious
talk, she sent for them and
prepared a banquet for them:

12:34 So his Lord *heard* to him (in his
prayer); and turned away from
him their snare: verily, He *hears*
and knows (all things).

13:14 any others that they call upon
besides Him *hear* them no more
than if they were to stretch forth
their hands for water to reach
their mouths but it reaches them
not:

17:1 for He is the One Who *hears* and
sees (all things).

18:11 Then We drew (a veil) over their
ears, for a number of years, in the
Cave, (so that they *heard* not):

18:26 how clearly He sees, how finely
He *hears* (everything)!

18:101 (Unbelievers) whose eyes had
been under a veil from
Remembrance of Me, and who
had been unable even to *hear*.

19:38 How plainly will they see and
hear, the Day that they will appear
before Us! but the unjust today
are in error manifest!

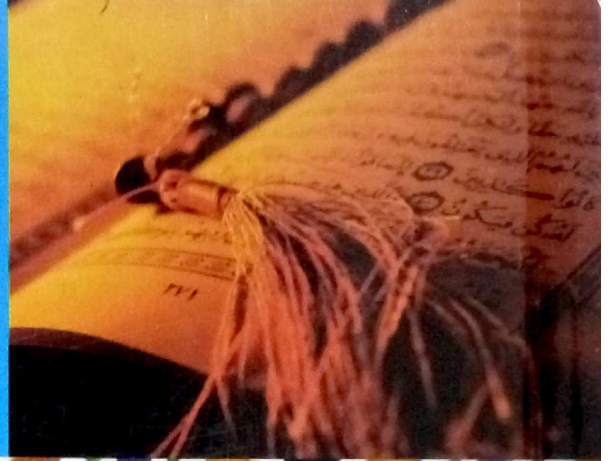
19:42 Behold, he said to his father: "O
my father! why worship that

can profit you nothing?"

19:62 They will not there *hear* any vain
discourse, but only salutations of
Peace.
